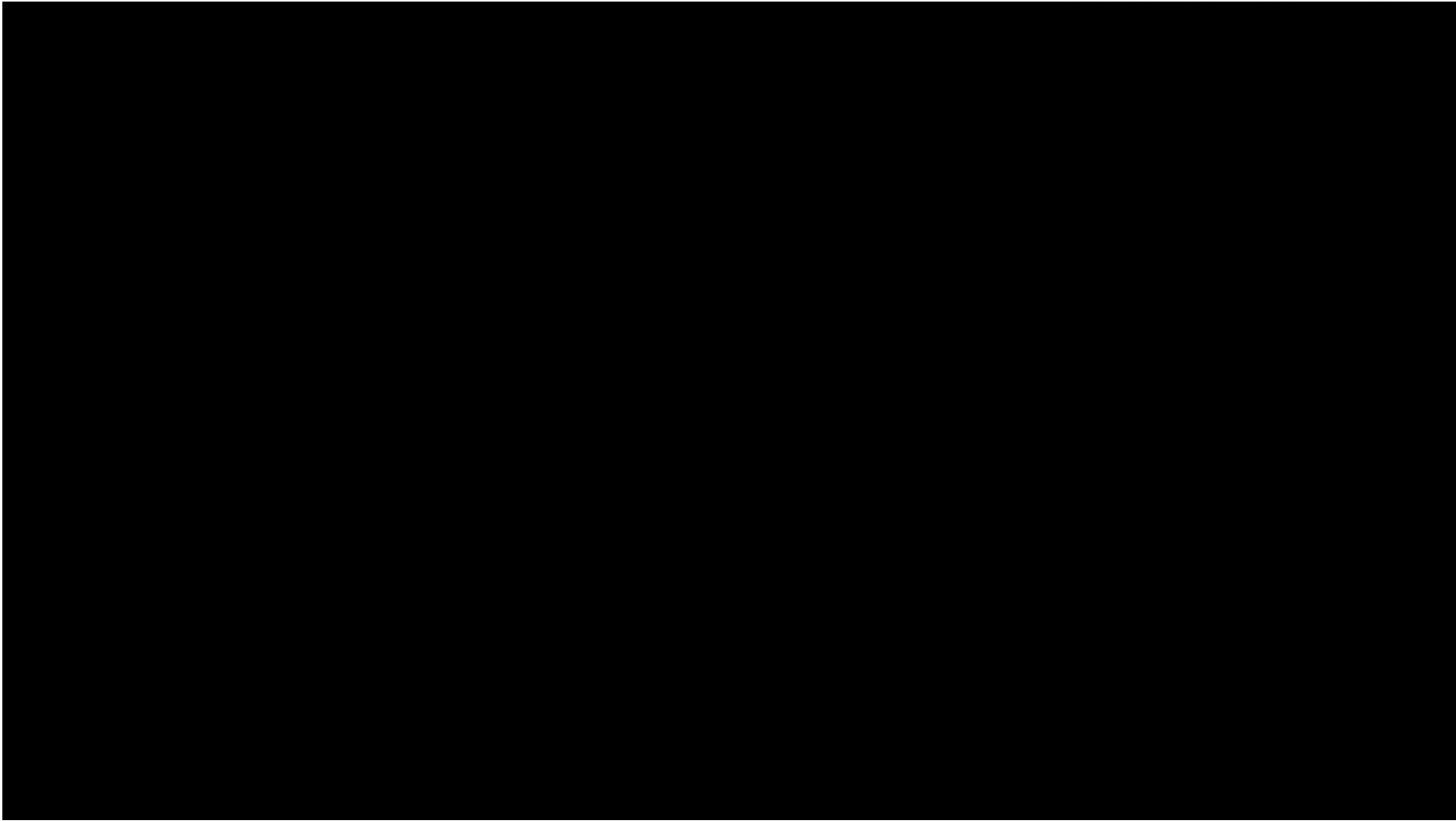

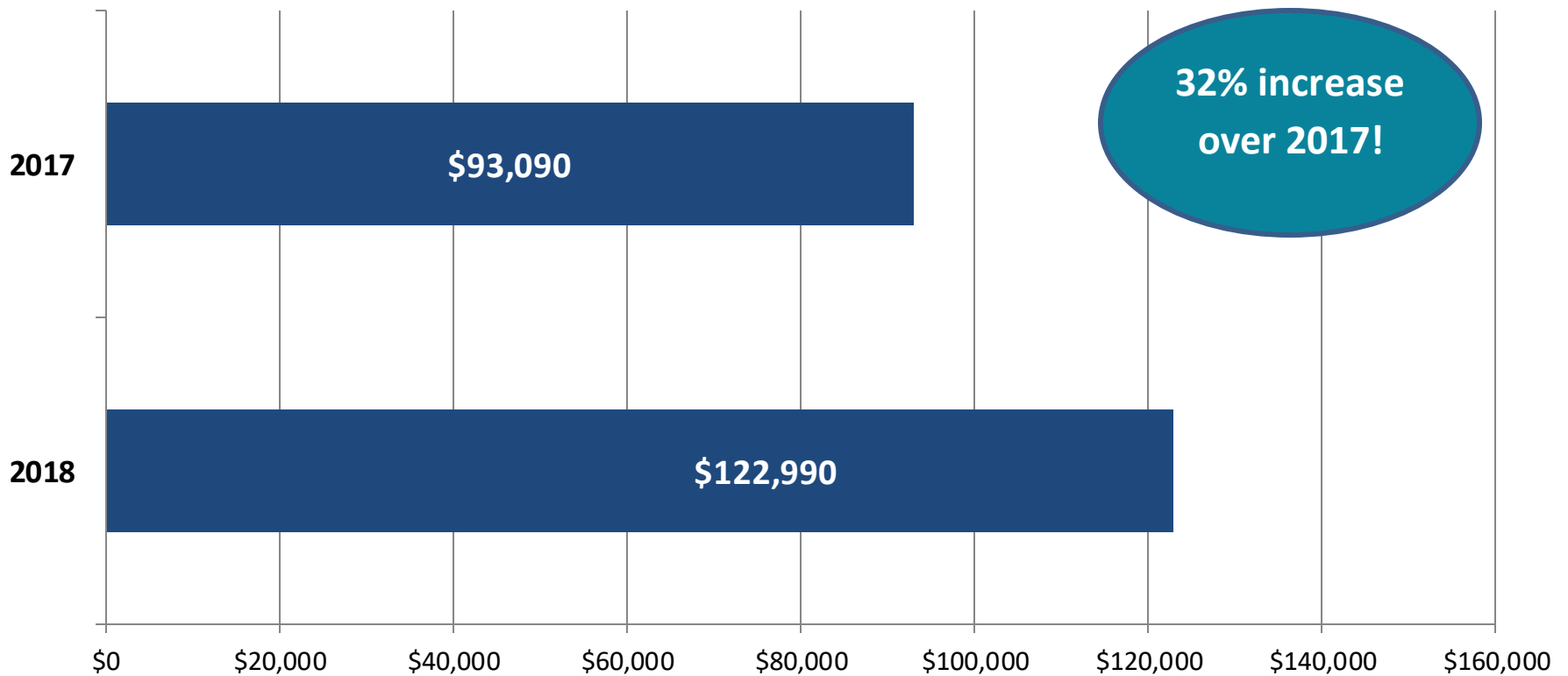

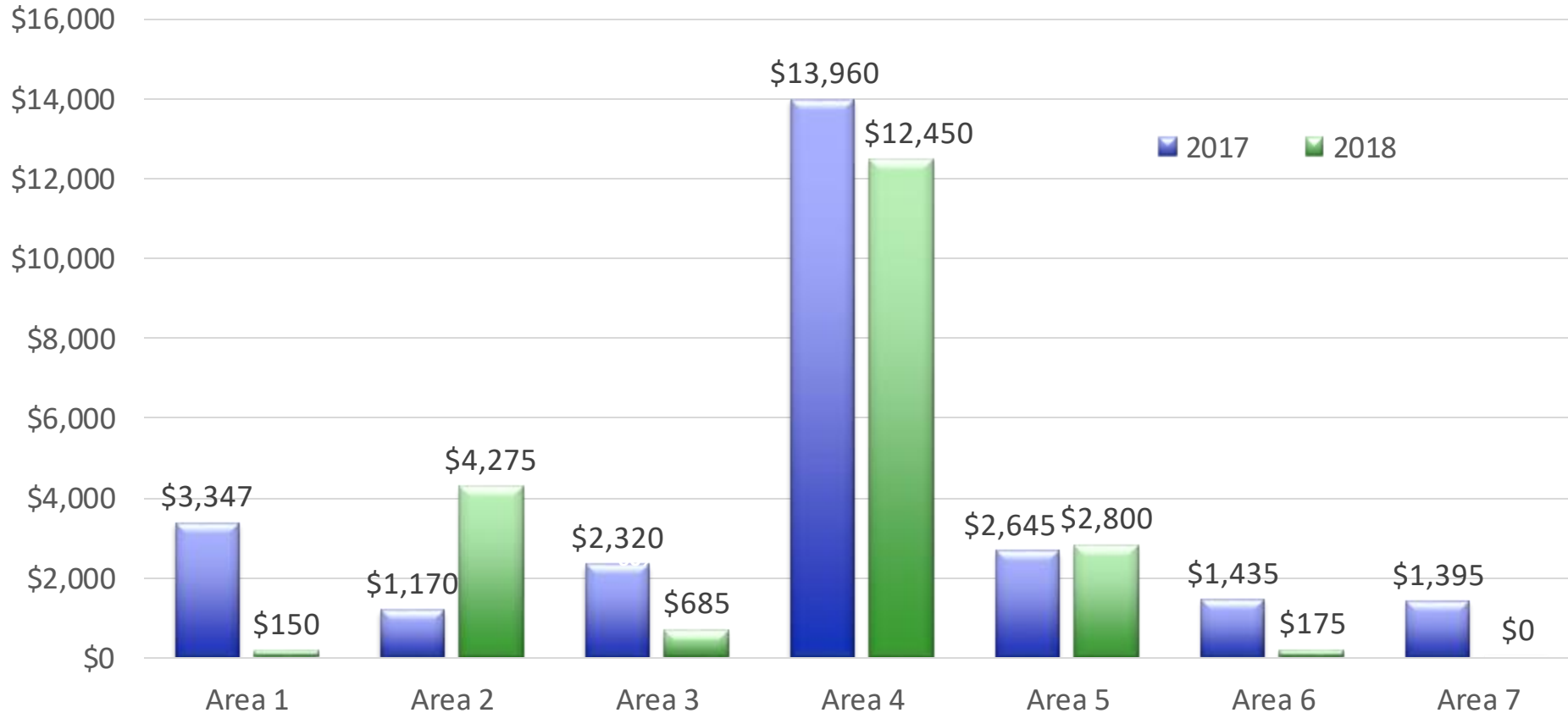

Foundation Gifts from Individuals: Year Over Year, January – September 2018

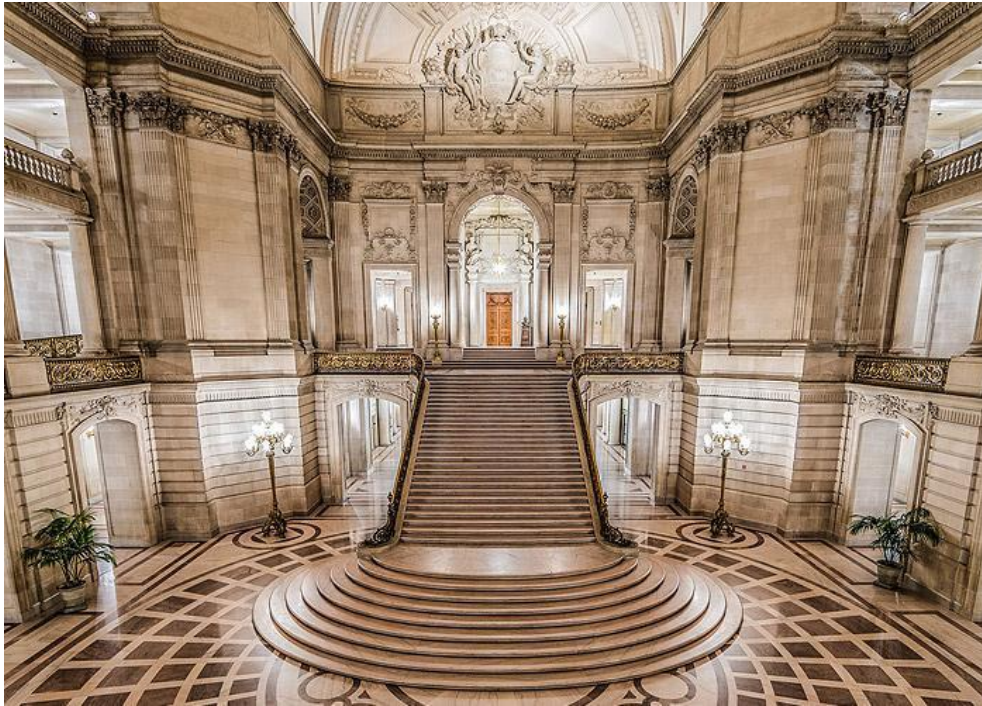
